NetSuite Supply Allocation

Target launch 1/30

What is Supply Allocation

Creates a **direct connection** between Supply and Demand

Supply

- Inventory
- Purchase Order
- Inbound Shipment
- Transfer Order
- Work Orders



Demand

- Sales Order

How is Supply Allocated

We created our own set of rules under Allocation Strategy, [Danby Allocation Strategy](#) which are applied when the Demand or Supply transactions are created or updated.

Demand Transaction Sorting

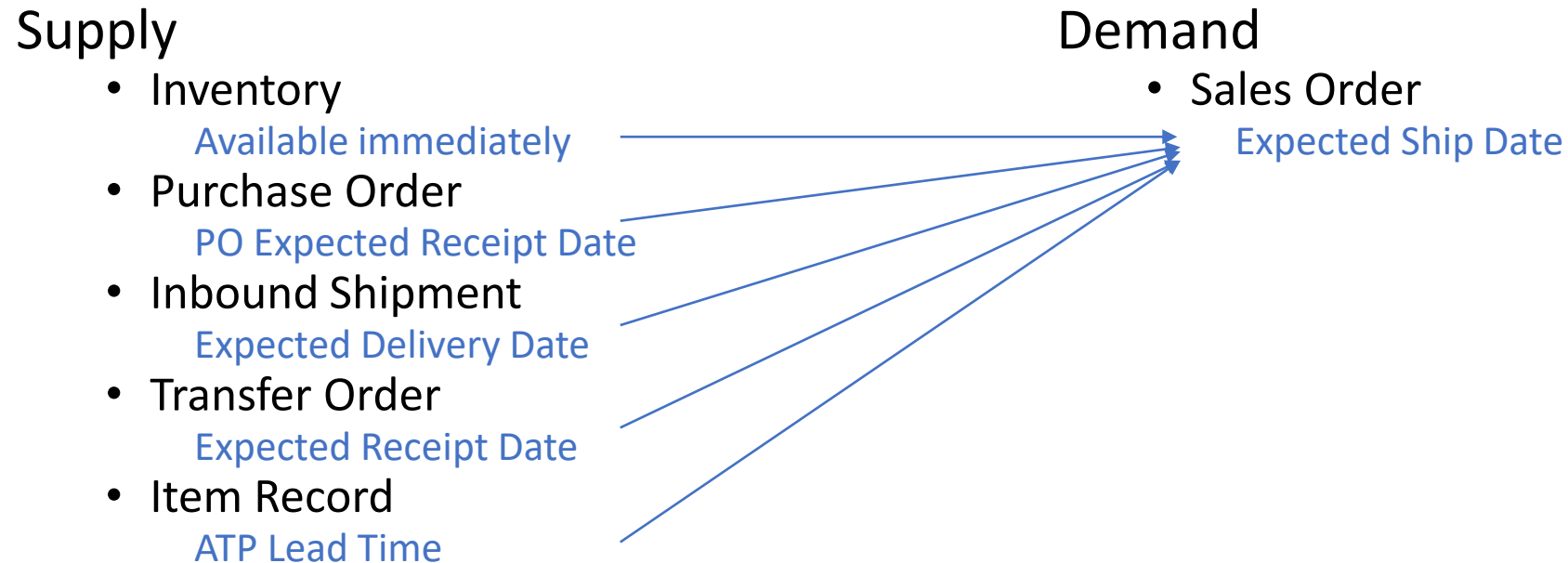
- 1) Sort by Supply Required by Date
aka Ship Date (Line)
- 2) Transaction Date

- No limits on Current and Future Inventory (may change)
- Allocate as soon as possible before Supply Required by Date
- Allocate the Complete Quantity
- Use ATP Lead Time
- Reserved Allocation (vs Firm)

NOTE: There is NO automatic reallocation. Once the allocation is made, it can only be changed manually by the Reallocation method.

Why Supply Allocation?

When the **direct connection** is made, we have a dynamic Expected Ship Date



When Supply dates change, the Demand dates change automatically. It will become extremely important that our Logistics support team maintain these dates.

Example

Supply

Inventory, Qty 1 On Hand

INBSHIP#1, Qty 5 Expected Delivery Date 6/1

INBSHIP#2, Qty 5 Expected Delivery Date 7/1

Demand

SO#1, Qty 1 Ship Date (Line) 5/20

Answer: Inventory, Expected Ship Date 5/20

SO#2, Qty 1 Ship Date (Line) 5/25

Answer: INBSHIP#1, Expected Ship Date 6/1

Warning: One or more order lines are not scheduled to be fulfilled by the Supply Required by Date

SO#3, Qty 1 Ship Date (Line) 7/2

Answer: INBSHIP#2, Expected Ship Date 7/1

Process: Qty 4 is available in inventory for immediate sale until 7/1 when we have additional inventory

Demo in RP (Release Preview)

- Gold Open Order Saved Search
 - Changing the ETA / Expected Ship Date terminology to “Inventory Available Date” since it sets a better expectation for customers
- Gold Open Order Report
- Sales Order – focus on line level changes
 - Allocated Supply
 - Supply Required by Date
 - Expected Ship Date
- Earliest Item Availability
 - Awesome new tool to use for predicting an Expected Ship Date
 - Replaces Check Item Availability form
 - Item 360 is a great tool – don’t forget this!
- Reallocate Items
 - To be used to manually reallocate inventory from one SO to another
- Supply Chain Control Tower
 - Increased visibility of our Supply Chain and at-risk transactions

Post Go Live


Added Re-Allocation Schedule

- Solves Transfer Order issue
- Changed the Sort order field to Transaction Date (from Ship Date)
- Runs every 12 hours based on warehouse “cut-off” time
- Added another Strategy
 - Available Qty (vs Complete Qty)
 - Workflow auto sets for Parts orders
- Commitment Confirmed
- Evaluating adding “limiting days”
 - Current and Future Inventory (limit before Supply Required by Date)
 - Future Inventory Only (limit after Supply Required by Date)
- Removed access to Reallocate Items page
 - Via script only

Supply Allocation Saved Search

Open Order Saved Search

- Grouping is a must due to the Ship Date field
- Summary Results are awkward to deal with
 - Let's add a Link "Button" to Sales Order

[Saved Transaction Search - Open Sales Orders \(SA\) - Gold - ONSUG \(netsuite.com\)](#)

Use AI (CoPilot) to help

Prompt 1 : Act as a NetSuite Administrator with 5 years experience specializing in Saved Searches

Prompt 2 : I have a saved search that groups transaction data together. Problem is clicking on a result line loads the drill down results. I would like to add a button on each line that will link to the transaction it refers to. Can you tell me what that formula would be?

Prompt 3 : In this css code, "Border: none", how would I change this to display a border?
